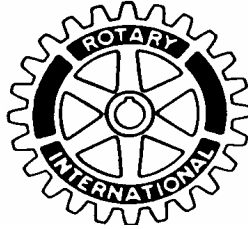

Last Week's Program

President Dave Heidl called the meeting to order. Jerry Royal did our invocation, pledge of allegiance, and recognition of guests and visiting Rotarians.

Announcements:

Sandy Long advised that the Roster Committee is updating the information on each of our members. All new members and members without photographs on file should come to the meeting a little early and have their picture taken for the directory. Chuck Caldwell announced that the Mudcats outing will be on July 21. The Raleigh Rescue Mission will supply transportation and the kids that we are to chaperone and host. The cost is about \$20 a person. Please contact Chuck if you can come and help.

Dave Heidl congratulated Woody Sherwood on his 50th wedding anniversary.

Dave Heidl told the Club that the Board recommended a dues increase of \$15 which would change the basic dues from \$120 per quarter to \$135 per quarter (plus the voluntary Foundation assessment of \$25 per quarter for a total of \$160 per quarter). Dave explained the justifications for the dues increase and indicated that most companion clubs in our area have higher dues than our club. A motion was made by Jim Lofton to accept the dues increase recommended by the Board, the motion was seconded by Tom Dugard, a vote was taken of the membership present, and the dues increase motion was unanimously approved.
